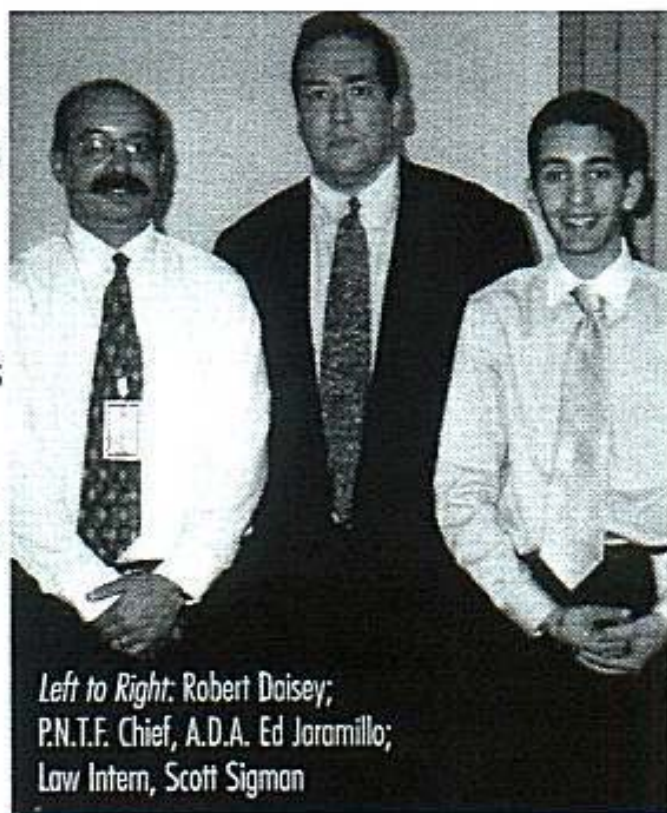


MAY THE FORCE BE WITH YOU

From the *Learn Something New Everyday File* comes this update from Scott Sigman, a Landmark resident, Temple University Law School student and law intern assigned to the Public Nuisance Task Force of the Philadelphia District Attorney's Office. This is the unit of the Narcotics Division responsible for closing drug houses, weed stores and nuisance bars; it also refers other nuisance complaints such as abandoned cars and VERY LOUD NOISE to appropriate City agencies.

Since 1992, the Task Force has been helping Philly residents combat nuisance problems in their neighborhoods. When someone makes a complaint, Task Force members talk to the neighbors, refer the problem to administrative and law enforcement agencies, and keep the community informed on the investigation or prosecution. The Task Force also connects communities with Town Watch, Civic and Block organizations and helps to ensure that other nuisances do not erupt in a community. Since its inception, the Task Force has seized, sealed and closed scores of nuisance properties.

Preserving, protecting and enhancing the Landmark lifestyle has always been a priority of Historic Landmarks for Living.
